SPONSORED FREE HEALTH CARE EVENTS FORM UPDATES

TITLE 16, CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION 1023.16

SECTION 100. CHANGE WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT

The Dental Board of California (Board) is amending Sections 1023.16 and 1023.17 of Article 8, Chapter 1, Division 10 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) to reflect non-substantive changes to the form entitled, "Registration of Sponsoring Entity Under Business & Professions Code Section 901," Form 901-A (DCA/2011), and the form entitled, "Request for Authorization to Practice Without a License at a Registered Free Health Care Event," Form DBC-901-B (New 02/2012), which were both incorporated by reference in the sections mentioned above. These proposed changes do not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription, or other regulatory element of any CCR provision.

The Board is proposing the following non-substantive changes to 16 CCR Section 1023.16:

- ". . . 'Registration of Sponsoring Entity Under Business & Professions Code Section 901,' Form 901-A (DCA/~~2011~~2014 - revised), which is herein incorporated by reference."
- "The board may, by resolution, delegate to the Department of Consumer Affairs the authority to receive and process "Registration of Sponsoring Entity Under Business & Professions Code Section 901," Form 901-A (DCA/~~2011~~2014 - revised) on behalf of the board."
- "The board, or its delegatee, shall inform the sponsoring entity within 15 calendar days of receipt of Form 901-A (DCA/~~2011~~2014 - revised) in writing that the form is either complete and the sponsoring entity is registered or that the form is deficient and what specific information or documentation is required to complete the form and be registered."

The Board is proposing the following non-substantive changes to 16 CCR Section 1023.17:

- "An applicant shall request authorization by submitting to the board a completed "Request for Authorization to Practice Without a License at a Registered Free Health Care Event," Form DBC-901-B (~~New 02/2012~~Revised 03/2014), which is hereby incorporated by reference, accompanied by a non-refundable processing fee of \$30."

- “The submitted Form DBC-901-B (~~New 02/2012~~Revised 03/2014) is incomplete and the applicant has not responded within 7 calendar days to the board's request for additional information”

The Board is proposing the following non-substantive changes to the form entitled, “Registration of Sponsoring Entity Under Business & Professions Code Section 901,” Form 901-A (DCA/2011):

- The form’s letterhead currently shows the Agency name as “State and Consumer Services Agency.” SB 1039 (Steinberg, Chapter 147, Statutes of 2012) eliminated the “State and Consumer Services Agency” and established the “Business, Consumer Services, and Housing Agency” to effectuate the Governor’s Reorganization Plan No. 2 (Plan). This Plan became effective July 3, 2012 and operative on July 1, 2013. Therefore, the form’s letterhead needs to be updated to reflect the new Agency name.
