



DENTISTRY FEE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014

Effective July 1, 2014, the fees for initial licensure and biennial renewal for dentists will increase to \$450.

Renewal notices sent out with an expiration date of July 30, 2014 and later will have to pay the increased fee, no matter when the renewal fee is submitted. Failure to pay the increased fee will result in the renewal not being issued.

Additionally, Senate Bill 809 (DeSaulnier, Chapter 400, Statutes of 2013) requires healthcare professional who are authorized to prescribe or fill prescriptions for controlled substances to pay \$6.00 annually to support the Controlled Substance Utilization Review and Evaluation System (CURES) and Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP). This fee is collected at the time of a licensee's renewal. Effective April 1, 2014, all dentists will see an additional \$12.00 added to their renewal fee (\$6.00 per year). This \$12.00 will be transferred to the State of California Department of Justice, Office of the Attorney General to fund the CURES/PDMP. Renewal notices sent out with an expiration date of April 30, 2014 and later will have to pay this fee, no matter when the renewal fee is submitted. Failure to pay these additional fees will result in the renewal not being issued.
